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METHODOLOGY



Time frame

This survey was fielded online by Quest Mindshare between March 5-12, 2021



Sample size

It reached a total of n=1,200 US respondents between the ages of 14 and 24 and is weighted to be nationally representative



Oversample

The results among California youth are from an oversample of n=300 youth in California among the same age range of 14 to 24

KEY FINDINGS

The environment and climate change

More than **eight out of 10** (83%) Gen Z youth are concerned about the health of the planet.

"The environment and climate change" has the second highest percentage (47%) of youth concerned about it of any issue, behind only "racism and social justice" (62%).

This is especially true in California, where **56%** of youth select it as one of the issues they are most concerned with.





Biden administration

Young people are more optimistic than not about the health of the planet since the Biden administration took office:

48% say they feel better about it compared to just 19% who say they feel worse. The gap is starker in California — 54% better / 15% worse.

And 60% of American youth / 63% of California youth believe the Biden administration will take steps to meaningfully address and combat climate change.

Generational perceptions

The gap between perceptions of their own generation vs. their parents' generation on climate change is wide.

Fully 62% of American youth / 66% of California youth say their generation takes climate change at least somewhat seriously.

Yet only 34% of American youth / 33% of California youth think their parents' generation takes climate change seriously.



Environment and personal health

Youth understand the connection between environment and personal health.

Fully 86% of American youth / 82% of California youth agree, usually strongly, that the quality of the environment where they live, work, and play affects their health and well-being.

A majority of respondents say that their environment has an effect on their physical health (69%) and their mental health (75%).

The top three environmental issues that young people are very concerned with are air quality (60%), water pollution (59%) and plastic pollution (56%) — but even natural disasters, wildfires, flooding and rising sea levels bring out at least some concerns for more than half of respondents.

Race and socioeconomics

For the most part, youth also understand the way socioeconomic factors and race/ethnicity factors interact with the environment and health.

64% of American youth agree that race/ethnic background affects health and well-being, including **33%** who feel this way strongly.

American youth also recognize how wealth can be a contributing factor to environmental protections with **54%** disagreeing that environmental protections are the same regardless of how rich or poor you are.





Impact on activities

About **one in three** (32%) have, at some point in the last five years, had an environmental event or natural disaster (not including COVID) interfere with their ability to exercise outside.

This is even more true for California youth, where **39%** say this.

One in four (26%) said that an environmental event or natural disaster has impacted their ability to concentrate in school.

Mental and physical symptoms

Mental symptoms such as stress, anxiety and depression top the list of symptoms experienced as a result of a natural disaster.

When it comes to physical symptoms, 31% have had headaches, 25% have had coughing or wheezing, 23% have had sore throat

Only 27% say they have not had a single symptom nationwide (24% in California).

Sustainable brands


79% of American youth / 76% of California youth say it is at least somewhat important to support brands and companies that are environmentally friendly or try to make their products sustainable.

KEY FIGURES

More than eight out of 10 (83%) Gen Z youth are concerned about the future health of the planet. More than half (54%) said they are 'very concerned' about the planet running out of resources.




How concerned are you about the future when you think of the following?



The top three environmental issues that young people are very concerned with are air quality (60%), water pollution (59%) and plastic pollution (56%).




How concerned are you about each of the following environmental issues when it comes to the future of the planet?




A majority of respondents say that the environment affects their physical health (69%) and their mental health (75%).



How much does the environment you live, work and play in affect your physical health/mental health?






One in four (26%) said that an environmental event or natural disaster – like a flood, fire or hurricane - has impacted their ability to concentrate in school.




PERCEPTIONS OF THE FUTURE

Racism and social justice is the top issue that youth are concerned with today.




Which of the following issues do you find yourself most concerned with today?



Youth in California (56%) are more inclined to say that they are concerned with the environment and climate change, than those nationwide (47%).




Which of the following issues do you find yourself most concerned with today?



Black youth are especially likely to be concerned with racism and social justice.




Which of the following issues do you find yourself most concerned with today?



54% of California youth feel at least somewhat better about the future health of the planet in the Biden administration. This is true for 48% of youth nationwide.

While liberals feel better about this considering the new administration (76%),


this is only true for 39% of moderates




and 59% of conservatives.

Do you think the Biden administration will take steps to meaningfully address and combat climate change?






71% of youth nationwide find it more or as difficult to address climate change during COVID. Often, this was because the pandemic was seen as a more pressing issue.

"COVID is the primary global issue at the moment. It's harder because COVID-19 is currently killing people at high rates, but climate change is killing us slowly."





Generally speaking, how seriously do you think your generation / your parents' generation takes climate change?







In California, 66% of youth think their generation takes climate change seriously, compared to only 33% that think the same of their parent's generations.



Generally speaking, how seriously do you think your generation / your parents' generation takes climate change?






HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENTAL CONCERNS

69% of youth nationwide say that their environment affects their physical health to some extent. Even more (75%) say their environment affects their mental health. This is particularly true among women.


How much does the environment you live, work and play in affect your physical health/mental health?




At least 6 out of 10 youth of all races say their physical health is affected by their environment. At least 7 out 10 youth of all races say their mental health is affected by their environment.



How much does the environment you live, work and play in affect your physical health/mental health?






Nationwide: At least two-thirds of youth are concerned about each issue asked about. Pollution is a top environmental issue youth say they are concerned about, with over half indicating they are very concerned.




How concerned are you about each of the following environmental issues when it comes to the future of the planet?

How concerned are you about each of the following environmental issues when it comes to your own personal health?






The top concerns among California youth are also pollution-related.




How concerned are you about each of the following environmental issues when it comes to the future of the planet?



While top concerns among California youth are also surrounding pollution, there is stronger concern around personal health and wildfires.

California youth are 14% more likely than youth nationwide to say that they are very/somewhat concerned about wildfires impacting their personal health.

They are 10% more likely to say this about extreme heat,


and 8% more likely to say this about drought and water shortages.

SOCIAL JUSTICE CONCERNS

Youth feel that it is the job of the government, federal as well as state and local, to protect citizens from the negative health effects of climate change. Youth in California feel similarly.




Who, if anyone, needs to do a better job when it comes to protecting citizens from negative health effects that may stem from climate change? Select your top three.



The role of government varies by political ideology, other options remained fairly consistent across ideologies.




Who, if anyone, needs to do a better job when it comes to protecting citizens from negative health effects that may stem from climate change? Select your top three.









About half (48%) of youth strongly agree that the quality of your environment affects your health and well-being.





At least 8 out of 10 youth of all races agree either strongly or somewhat that your environment affects health and well-being.





About one-third of youth strongly agree that in the US, race and ethnic background affect health and well-being.





Black youth are more likely to strongly agree with this sentiment than others.





27% of youth nationwide agree to some extent that fighting climate change is one way to fight racism. This is slightly higher (32%) among California youth.




Please indicate whether you agree or disagree with this statement: Fighting climate change is one way to fight racism.



Again, Black youth are more likely than others to strongly agree with this sentiment, however only 14% indicated so.




Please indicate whether you agree or disagree with this statement: Fighting climate change is one way to fight racism.







Have you ever participated in a cause or event dedicated to combating climate change or helping the environment?





Where did you learn about the environmental issue or cause? Select all that apply.




IMPACT ON LIFE




Anxiety was the most common mental health symptom stemming from a natural disaster or an environmental event, with one in three California youth indicating they've experienced this.

Headaches, coughing or wheezing and sore throats are common physical symptoms stemming from natural disasters or environmental events.


Have you ever experienced any of the following, related to a natural disaster or an environmental event, such as from a wildfire, flooding, extremely hot or cold days, hurricane etc.?


Nationwide: Youth are as concerned with the future health of the planet (83%) as they are with having a career that pays enough (81%).

How concerned are you about the future when you think of the following?






Half of youth perceive that the current state of the climate and environment will impact the future of where they live and the natural resources they use.

More of women's future decisions are impacted by the climate and environment than men's, particularly when it comes to where they will live, the food they will eat, plastic material usage and where they will food shop.


For which of the following, if any, does the current state of the climate and environment affect your decisions about the future? Select all that apply.
